- We are looking for the top acts in the four categories to advance to the finals...
- Minimum 4 people/ team (any combination, boys, girls, people from other youth groups, sponsors)
- Individuals may only be part of 1 group, performing in 1 of the 4 categories (due to time restraints)
- Maximum 60 sec. performance
- Bring your own equipment and copy of music on a CD, MP3 player or USB key (We will try to make the music available also!)

Teams can choose from the following categories:

1. Dance- choreograph a dance to one of the listed songs for up to 60 sec.
2. Group Song- sing a group number together to one of the following listed songs (we recommend you try to get a track without lyrics or play your own instruments) 60 sec. MAX
3. Drama/ Skit- Perform a dramatic presentation to one of these 4 popular Movies: 60 sec MAX
